
Campaign Prayer



Words from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Stephen's,

- St. Stephen's needs your help and support with a very challenging and crucial repair and renovation project.
- St. Stephen's Parish has a rich history of providing for the spiritual, pastoral and educational needs of our parishioners. We have been blessed over the years with many opportunities to serve our parish families in our walk with Christ. We are thankful for the generations of dedicated people who have given their time, shared their talent and treasure. Many of those people may have been your parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, cousins or former neighbors. Their support and dedication has helped St. Stephen's to remain an active and growing parish. We have come a long way since our humble beginnings in 1831, when our ancestors gathered to pray in a log cabin that had no windows or doors with only an opening covered with cloth to keep out the cold and prevent the wind from putting out the candles.

For several months small pieces of plaster have been found on the carpet in a few locations in church and cracks in the plaster have become more visible. Brian Baker, owner of *Baker Liturgical Art LLC* was contacted and asked to inspect the church ceiling and evaluate the condition of the plaster. Their inspection determined that the ceiling is compromised and needs to be stabilized to prevent possible collapse. The specialized conservation process that *Baker Liturgical Art LLC* will use is a system that will stabilize and repair the ceiling. The beautiful artwork and canvas murals painted by Professor Louis Carracciolo, who studied in Urbino, Italy, can be preserved. We believe the factors that aided in the deterioration of the ceiling will be corrected and the ceiling will be preserved for many future generations. The repair of the ceiling will also assure the safety of our beautiful 1910 Moller Pipe Organ.

St. Stephen's Church was built in 1902 under the direction and guidance of Fr. Leo Heinrichs, OFM. Fr. Leo was sent to rebuild the church after a fire destroyed 21 buildings in the Village. He was a humble Franciscan Friar, dedicated to poverty, chastity and obedience and spent countless hours traveling miles in below zero temperatures to the lumber camps, seeking donations to build this church. Fr. Leo was shot and killed on Feb. 24, 1908 by an anarchist in Denver, Colorado while giving out Holy Communion. One hidden aspect of his life came to light when his body was prepared for burial. He had deep calloused furrows from chains of steel wire, spiked at intervals, and wrapped tightly around both arms and his waist. His name appears in the American Martylogy. He is one of 125 persons who died for their faith here in the United States. There have been 40 extraordinary cures documented and attributed to the intercession of Fr. Leo. His portrait hangs in the back of St. Stephen's Church as a reminder of the deep-seated history and the burdens and sacrifices of our Catholic ancestors. To many, St. Stephen's Church is a landmark. The steeple that rises to 140 feet can be seen from all directions when entering the Village of Croghan.

We need your help in "Restoring Our Tradition." The estimate to repair/restore the ceiling (nave) includes the sanctuary, side aisles, walls, choir loft, vestibules, paint and re-stencil with like colors, cleaning statues, stations of the cross, etc. is \$ 1,400,000.

As we follow in Fr. Leo's footsteps and reach beyond our parish boundaries, we ask you to prayerfully consider a gift from your heart; a gift blessed with your sacrifice; a gift in memory of a loved one; a gift of prayer for guidance and hope.

Please help us to accomplish this massive undertaking. The willingness and dedication of our parish families, extended friends and family as we move forward in "Restoring our Tradition" is also an assurance of securing the future of our Parish for many generations that will follow as a community aware that God is the source of all that we have, a community committed to giving example to the Gospel values of worship, belief, service and a source of hope for our people.

May God bless you and all your loved ones. St. Stephen, pray for us.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What projects are planned for my contribution?

With your generous financial support our parish plans to stabilize the church and sanctuary ceilings, restore the murals and artwork, upgrade electrical and add insulation and ventilation to the ceilings and roof area.

Q. When will the work begin?

The major restoration of the ceilings will begin April 2016 and the other projects will follow along as things progress and the funds become available.

Q. What will happen if we go over our goal?

If we should go over our goal, funds will be set aside for future needs.

Q. What if I never make pledges?

Most people take advantage of time-payments for major purchases. A pledge to our Capital Campaign is a "time-payment plan" that makes it possible for you to meet your parish obligations without undue hardship. Pledges enable you to consider a more significant contribution to the campaign rather than a one-time gift.

Q. Is my pledge over and above my Sunday Offering?

Yes. We can only reach our goal with a little extra sacrifice. We cannot reach our goal if we reduce our weekly offerings in order to make a pledge to the Capital Campaign. St. Stephen's Church will continue to have normal operating expenses during the pledge period.

Q. What if I am currently unemployed?

You cannot give what you do not have. You can still pledge and defer payment until your financial situation improves.

Q. Who will be asked to support the Campaign?

Each member of our parish family will be asked to consider a significant gift for this major effort according to his or her financial ability. We will make a special appeal to parishioners who have been blessed by the Lord with exceptional earning ability or have been able to accumulate some assets. We hope each parish family member will play a conscientious role in restoring the heritage and renewing the future of St. Stephen's Church.

Q. What happens if I cannot fulfill my pledge?

Pledges are made in good faith and accepted as such. If hardship or illness prevents you from fulfilling your pledge, let the parish know, and other arrangements will be made.

Q. Will there be additional information made available concerning the Campaign?

Stocks and Bonds

There are added advantages to giving stocks, bonds, and securities. IRA Gifts

If you are over 70 1/2 years old, you may also be eligible to make a charitable gift from your IRA assets. These types of gifts must be transferred directly and count toward your minimum required distribution.



Q.Why would my family and I wish to have a leaf or a rock on the Giving Tree?

A leaf on the Tree is an everlasting way to remember a loved one; to share your pride in our parish; to celebrate an important, joyous, and memorable event such as the birth of a child or grandchild, a marriage, an anniversary, etc.; as well as a unique way to help your parish financially.

Q. When do I submit my personal inscription for my leaf or rock?

Inscription slips will be sent to you soon after you make your pledge. All you need to do is fill out the inscription slip as you desire and drop it in the mail or bring it to the parish office.

Q.When will my leaf or rock be placed on the Tree?

About three or four weeks after you hand in your inscription slip.

Memorials are reserved on a first-come, firstserved basis and are designated only once in the campaign. Donors choosing to sponsor one of the memorials will be permanently recognized.
